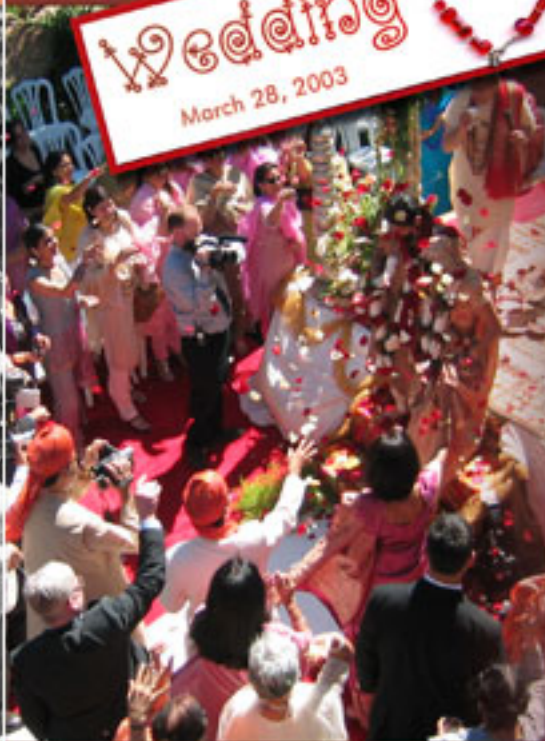

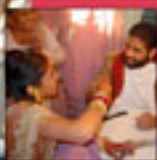

March 30th - April 6th 2004

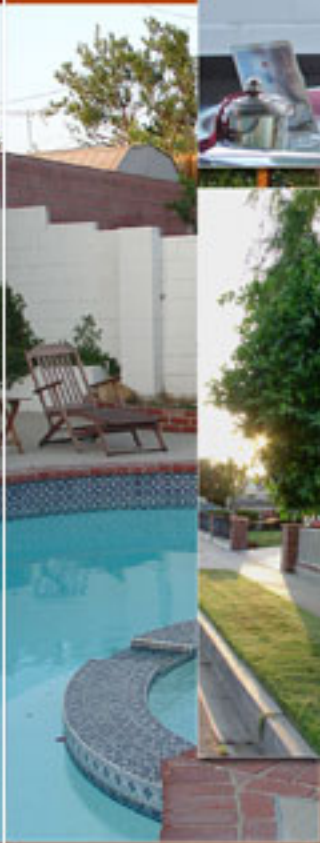

First night: We slept in Nick's tiny twin bed in our yellow and green guest room because our mattress hadn't arrived yet. Perfect for a honeymooning couple.

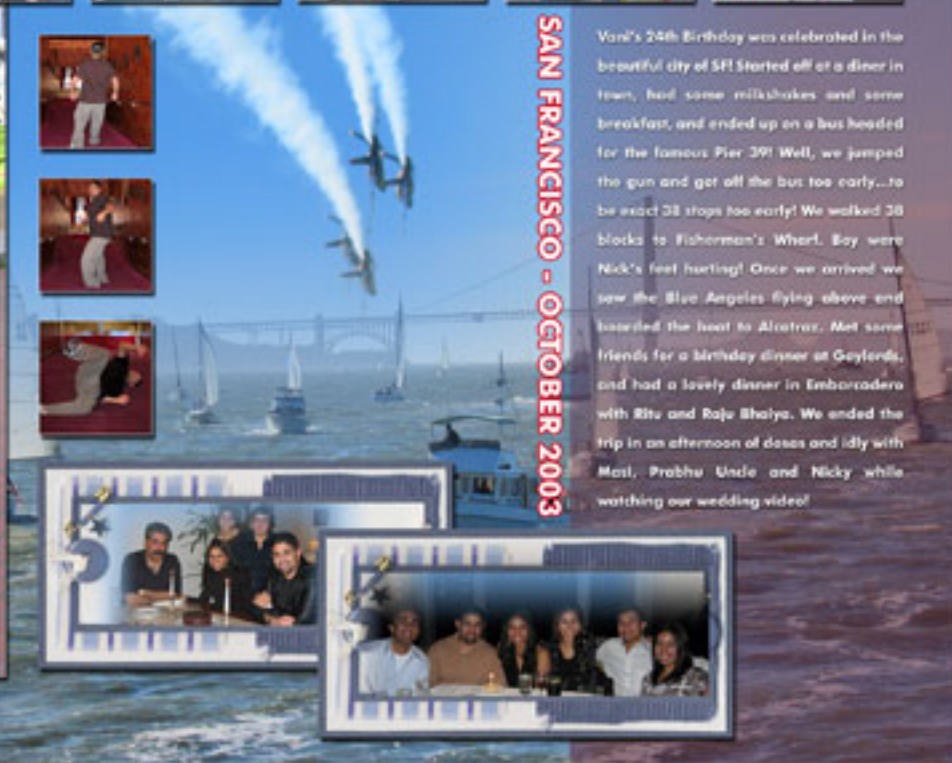

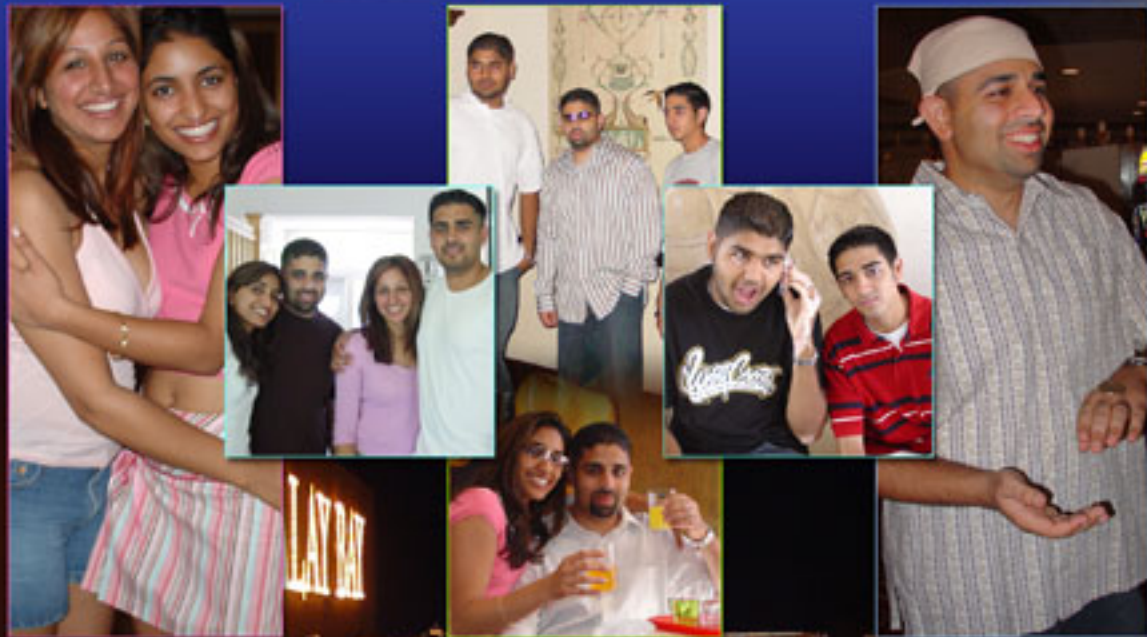
MARCH 28TH, 2004 / ORLANDO, FLORIDA

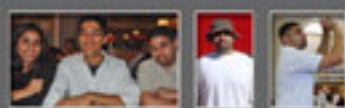

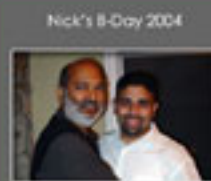
